

## Rules for Lawn & Garden Tractor Pull

### Age 11 years and under:

All participants must be registered by their parent or guardian.

A helmet must be worn during the pull.

All drivers must wear long pants, shirt and shoes. No sandals allowed.

A properly equipped tractor will be provided for their use.

A drivers meeting will be held before the start of the pull to go over the safety rules.

Parent or Guardian must be present at the time of pull.

Only tractor, driver, parent or guardian and safety officer are to be in the pulling area at the time of the pull.

Only one tractor may be running at a time. All others must be shut off.

A kill switch will be temporarily hooked up to the tractor at the time of the pull and controlled by the safety officer.

All tractors must be in neutral when hooking up to the sled.

Both hands are to be held up in the air so that hookup person knows it is safe to approach the tractor.

If the tractor stalls everyone must stand clear while operator safely restarts it.

### Age 12 years and older:

All participants under 18 years of age must be registered by their parent or guardian.

All participants between the ages of 12 and 16 years must attend a safety course and pass the test before being allowed to pull. Date of course to be announced.

A helmet must be worn during the pull.

All drivers must wear long pants, shirt and shoes. No sandals allowed.

A drivers meeting will be held before the start of the pull to go over the safety rules.

Parent or Guardian must be present at the time of pull.

Only tractor, driver, parent or guardian and safety officer are to be in the pulling area at the time of the pull.

Only one tractor may be running at a time. All others must be shut off.

A kill switch will be temporarily hooked up to the tractor at the time of the pull and controlled by the safety officer.

All tractors must be in neutral when hooking up to the sled.

Both hands are to be held up in the air so that hookup person knows it is safe to approach the tractor.

If the tractor stalls everyone must stand clear while operator safely restarts it.

### Safety equipment requirements:

Any year garden tractor will be accepted.

Tractor must have wheelie bars or skid plate so front wheels don't come off the ground more than 6 inches.

Hitch height can be no more than 12 inches.

Brakes must be operational.

All moving parts must be covered.

No implements or mower decks are allowed on the tractors.
